The long range planning meeting scheduled for August 17th and all subsequent meetings are put on hold/cancelled until after we have worked through disaffiliation.

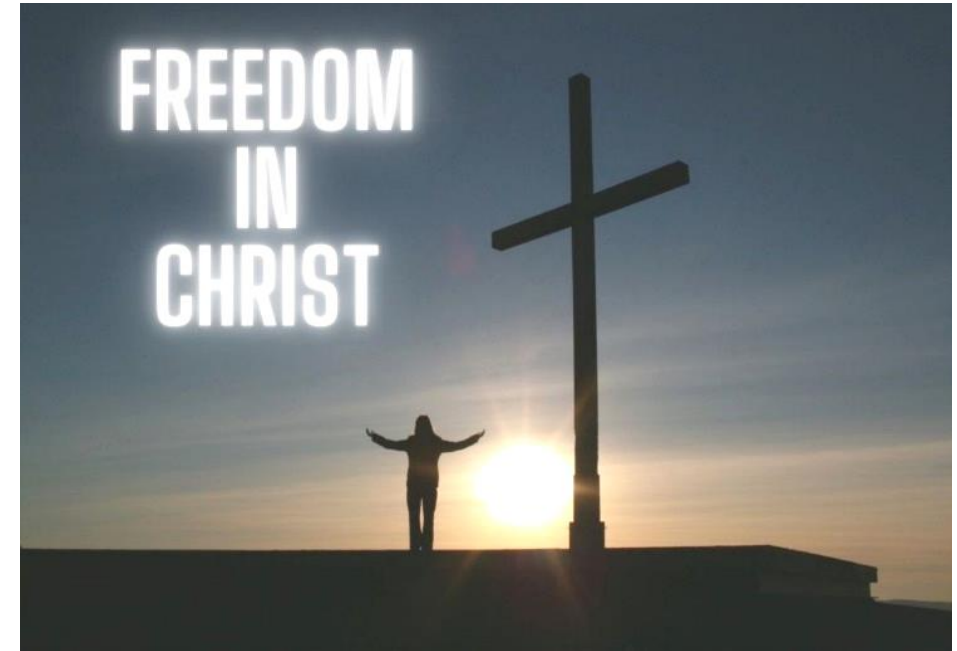
YOU'RE INVITED: COOKBOOK PLANNING MEETING
