YOUTH UPDATES

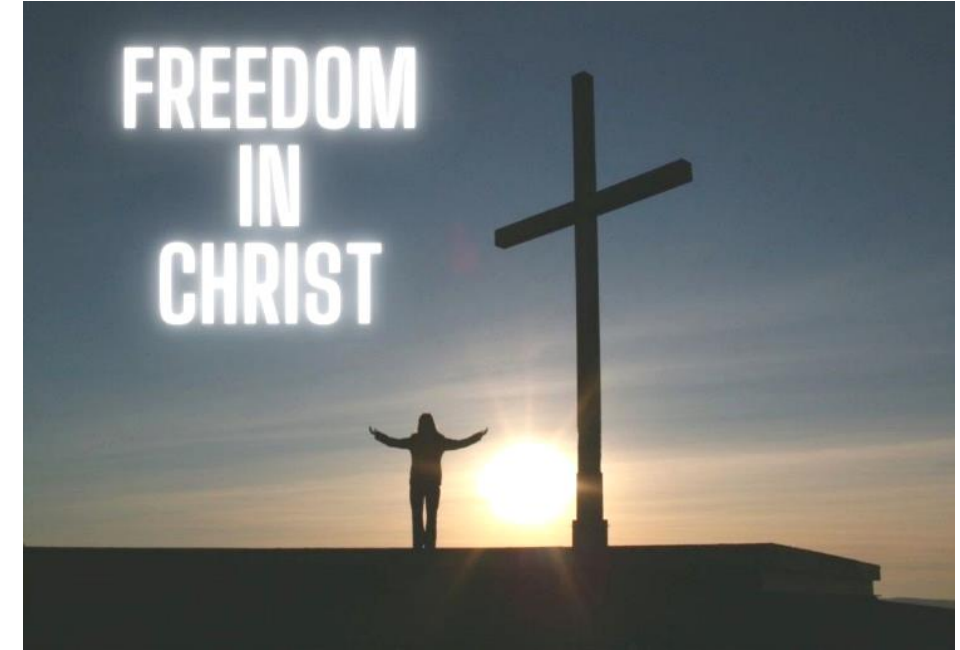
