HOME SUPPER CLUB

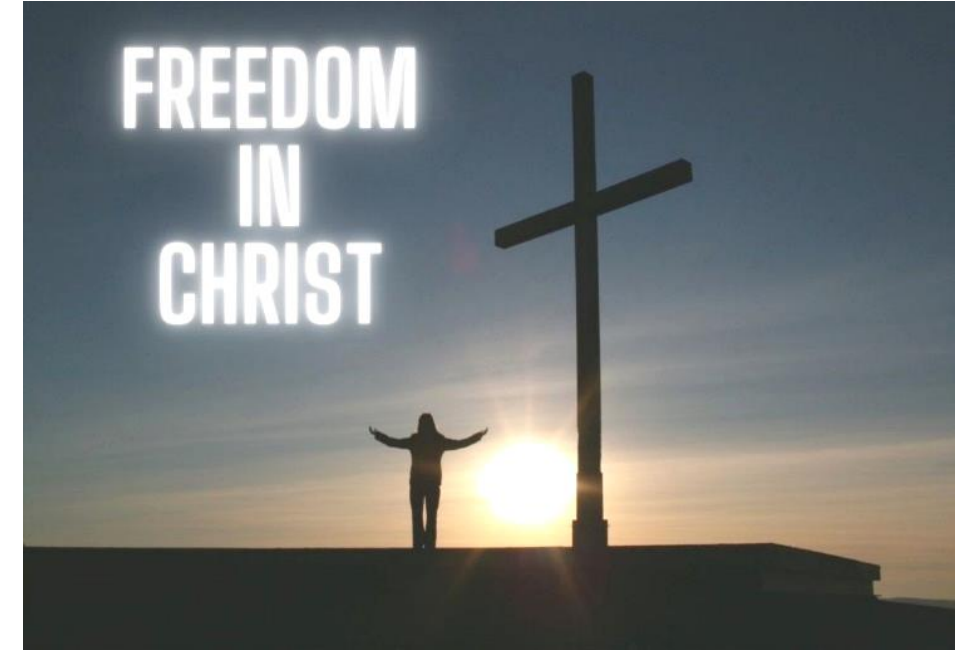
