### FALL FESTIVAL

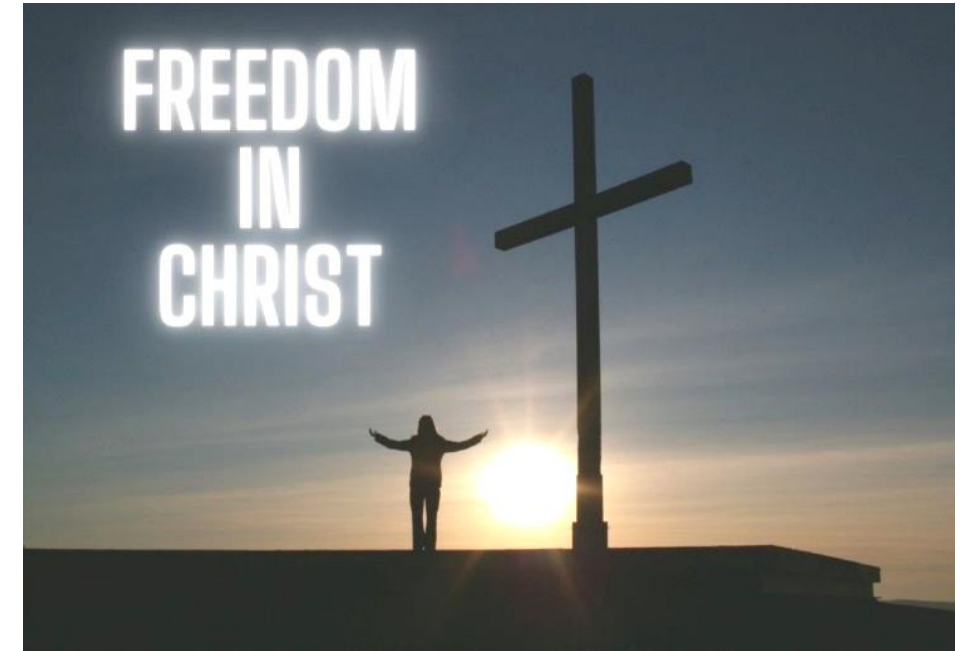
