FALL FESTIVAL

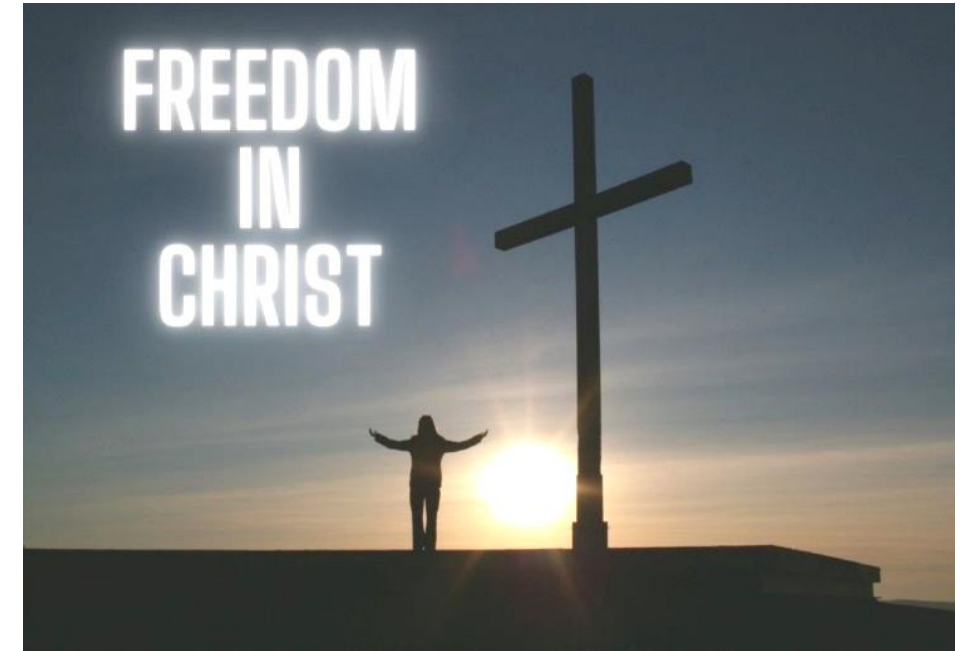
