### MISSION HOUSE

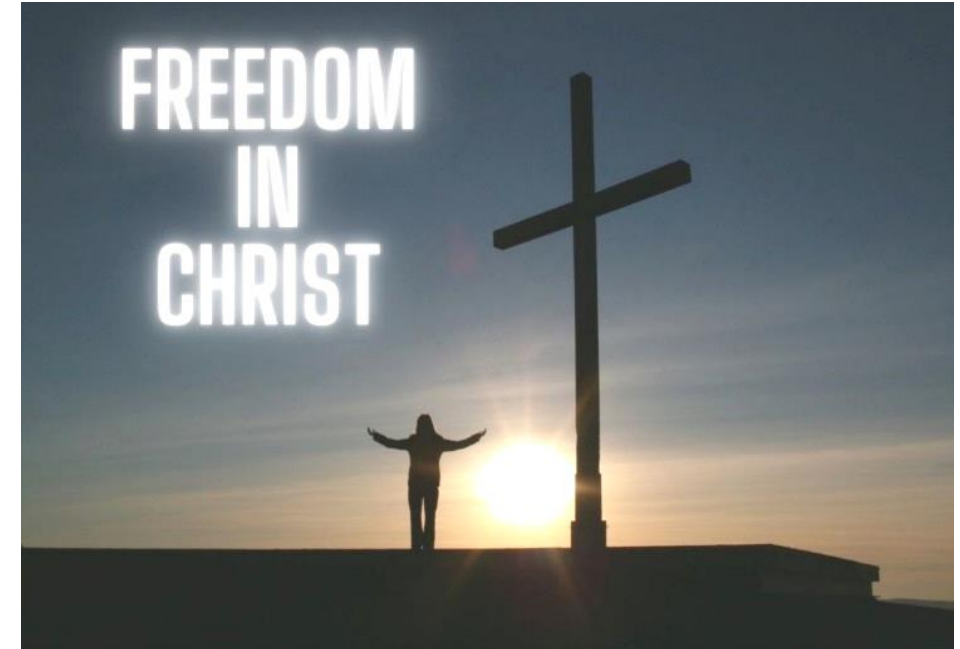
