MISSION HOUSE

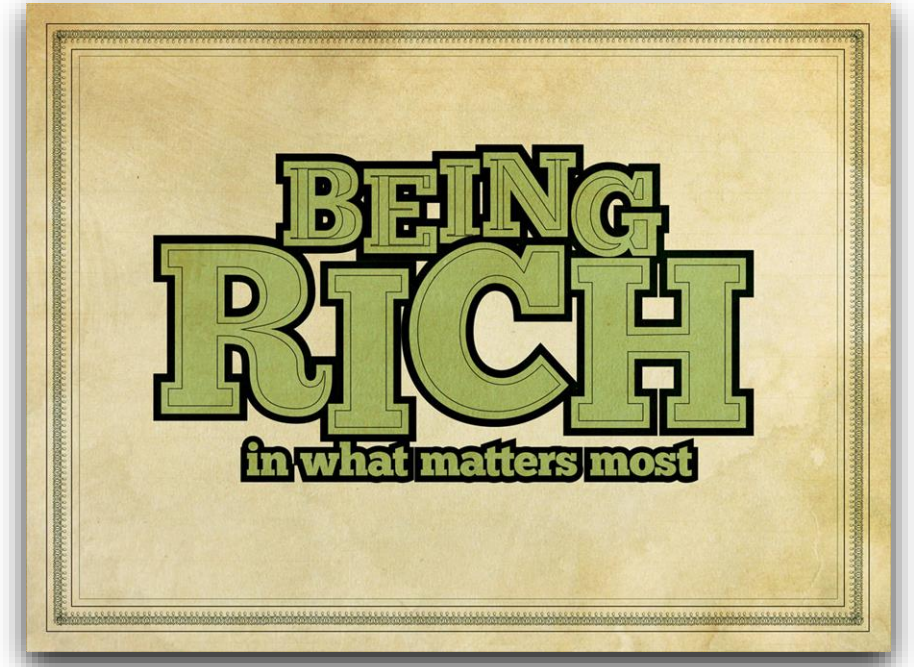
