A Season of Prayer and Fasting



A few weeks ago I began to call us to a season of prayer and fasting for our church and mission. You can sign up by going to this website https://www.signupgenius.com/go/70a0d4da4ab2ea2fb6-prayer#/. If you don't have access to the internet, you can call our church office at 283-2195 to sign up as well.

Why would I call one another to a season of fasting and prayer? Because we want to see God do something new among us at First Methodist! When Jesus was preparing for his public ministry, he was led by the Holy Spirit into the wilderness for a forty-day season of fasting and prayer (Luke 4:1-2). Jesus himself tells us that some things can only happen through times of prayer and fasting (Mark 9:29).

As we move through this holy season of Lent, let us devote ourselves to prayer and fasting as a way of preparing ourselves for what God wants to do through us. We know that God will work in powerful ways in our Tallassee community, and we want to be fully surrendered to that work.

So I encourage and invite you to commit to a day each week to fast and pray (either from sundown to sundown or simply three meals on the same day). A full fast is from all food (water or beverages only). Food fasts are considered the "gold standard" of fasting and are what is described in the Bible. However, if for health reasons

you are not able to fast from food, consider fasting from television or social media or anything that frees up more time for prayer in your day.

Seeking God's will and ways through prayer and fasting can be a rich and beautiful experience, and my hope is that it will deepen our faith and clear the way for God to move in our life together as a church!


