We had a wonderful time at VBS!

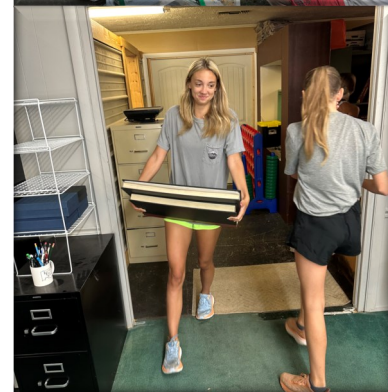
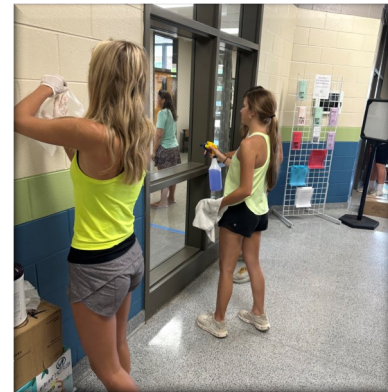

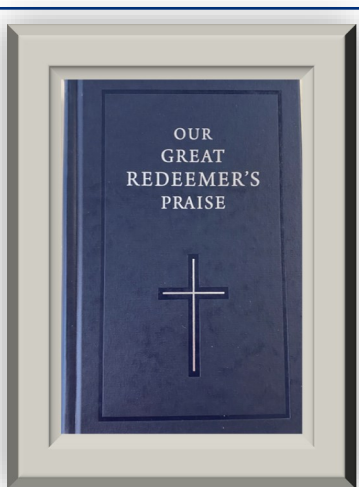
New Beginnings Campaign
