Fish of Ichthus

Jesus Christ, God's Son, Savior

"My soul glorifies the Lord and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior, for he has been mindful of the humble state of his servant. From now on all generations will call me blessed." Luke 1:46-48

Manger

The manger in which Mary placed the baby Jesus

"...and she gave birth to her firstborn, a son. She wrapped him in cloths and placed him in a manger, because there was no guest room available for them." Luke 2:7

Alpha Omega

The Beginning and the End

"I am Alpha and Omega—the beginning and the end, the first and the last." Revelation 1:8

Butterfly Resurrection and New Life

"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, a new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!" 2 Corinthians 5:17

Cross and Crown

Symbolizing that Jesus is the King of Kings

Triangle

Symbol of the Holy Spirit

Crown of Thorns

Passion symbol of the Crucifixion of the Lord
