### Our Plan For Spiritual Growth

You've undoubtedly noticed the words "Commit, Connect, Engage" on our bulletins, newsletters and websites. Our church family has long used those words to describe a simple plan to grow people in their walk with Jesus Christ.

Our mission statement reads like this:

The mission of First Methodist Church of Tallassee is to make disciples by calling people to love God, connect with one another, and engage in service to the world.

This is our plan for growing people in discipleship. The first step (commit) is to grow in our love for God, and the weekend worship services are the main way people grow in that love. The worship service is where guests, new people, and nonbelievers enter the church. It is also the time every week where believers draw close to God through prayer, music, and teaching. This is the first step in the process of growing as a disciple.

The second step (connect) means to grow in relationship with other believers. This is one of the most important ways that we grow in our walk with Jesus. John Wesley famously said that "there is no holiness but social holiness", which meant that we grow in our love for God as we learn to connect with and love our brothers and sisters in Christ. Small groups, Sunday School classes, and discipleship bands are the best environment for people to connect with one another in biblical community. So we are always encouraging one another to plug into a group.

The "engage" step means to serve the world by being on one of our ministry teams. These are the various groups in our church where we serve others either in our church or in our community. When we see God working through us in service, our faith and trust in God grows and matures.

I love that First Methodist uses this simple "Commit, Connect, Engage" model. It is a clear and simple plan for leading people to be followers of Jesus Christ, and that is the reason we are here!

The class wants to thank everyone who helped in anyway with the brunch. They were so happy to spread a little Christmas joy to these special members of our church.










# Crafty Christians
